- Images must have a road safety message, be colourful and inventive, using paints, crayons, colouring pencils or collage (ideally NOT computer generated)

- All entries must include your full name, school, class year and contact details. This is so we can contact you if you are amongst the winners and can correctly credit the artwork
- Please don't write your name or contact details on the front of the image itself (ideally put the info on the back)
