- The location of the anti-social driving or abandoned vehicle. Please try to include house numbers, shop names, road names or local landmarks to narrow it down
- The vehicle make, model and number plate will greatly help enquiries
- A brief description of what you witnessed
- Please include your email to ensure that you can be contacted or updated easily

You will need the same information as above and the operator will take you through your report.

Your information, whether submitted online or by telephone, will help Sussex Police to take appropriate action to improve your community.
